

Open Data Specifications, First ed.

Following Article 2 of the Declaration of Cooperation (Established March 18, 2020), hereby we release the specifications of the open data made available by the Parties. The specifications are as follows:

1. Open data provided by the Parties consists of images of historical Chinese characters and related metadata. These data follow the International Image Interoperability Framework (IIIF) standards.
2. The Parties make IIIF manifest files publicly available.
3. The Parties grant the following metadata to each image:
 - a) Unique ID for each image. (Following the regulations of each institution)
 - b) Unicode UTF-8.
 - c) Source of the image.
 - d) Name of the source database.
 - e) Name of the data-providing institution.
4. The Parties also Grant the following metadata as possible:
 - a) Time data.
 - b) Space data.
5. Every image complies with the following standards:
 - a) The image resolution is around 300 dpi.
 - b) The image falls under a creative commons CC-BY SA license.
